

If you liked "Baking Soda Surprise Eggs", try: It's a Gas! with items you may have around your house!

Materials You Will Need:

- a balloon (12 in.)
- a small funnel or a piece of paper rolled up in a funnel shape
- 3t baking soda
- vinegar
- a 12 or 20oz plastic bottle)



DIRECTIONS

1) Using the funnel, add 3 teaspoons of baking soda to your balloon.

2) Fill your plastic bottle 1/3 of the way full with vinegar.

3) Without dropping in the baking soda, stretch and fit the balloon top over the bottle opening.

PREDICT: What do you think will happen when the baking soda hits the vinegar?

4) Hold up the balloon and let the baking soda fall into the vinegar.

5) Watch what happens when the baking soda and vinegar mix!

Why does this work?

The vinegar mixes with the baking soda to create a chemical reaction that produces carbon dioxide gas. The gas then blows up the balloon!
