


The Longest Storm

by Ryan T. Higgins Grumpy Bruce the bear does not like


neighbors, but is forced to help when a big storm draws them all to his home.

by Joanna Cole


Instead of visiting the weather station, Ms. Frizzle's class experiences a hurricane firsthand, from air, sea, and land.
