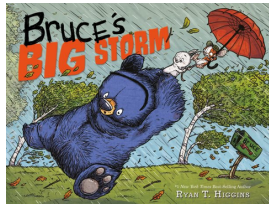




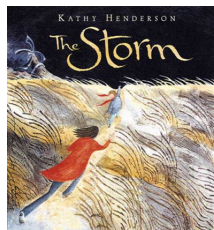
**The Longest Storm**

The family has to hunker down together, with no going outside. That's hard when there's absolutely nothing to do, and everyone is getting on everyone else's nerves.



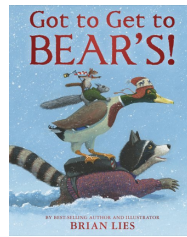
**Bruce's Big Storm**

Grumpy Bruce the bear does not like neighbors, but is forced to help when a big storm draws them all to his home.



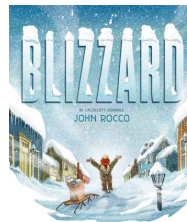
**The Storm**

When a fierce storm threatens their seaside home, Jim and his mother take refuge at his grandmother's house up the hill.



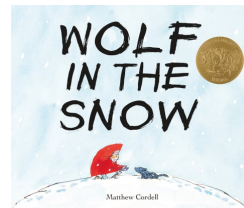
**Got to Get to Bear's!**

A boy becomes a hero when he manages to walk to the local store and bring supplies back to his neighborhood which has been snowed in for days. Based on the author's childhood experience.



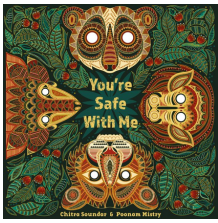
**Wolf in the Snow**

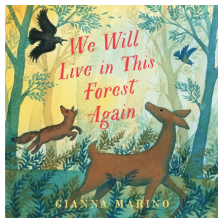
**You're Safe With Me**

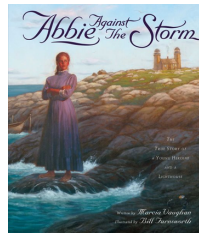
**Wildfire!**

Illustrations and easy-to-read text reveal the struggles of forest animals to survive when fire breaks out, and the actions of the firefighters who work through the night to stop the blaze.



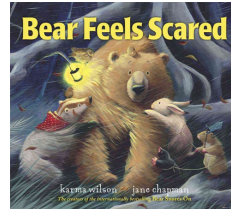
**We Will Live in This Forest Again**

When a thriving forest is swallowed by wildfire, its residents brace themselves and look to new beginnings



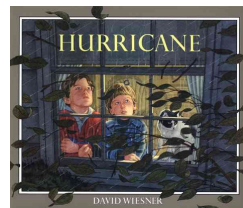
**Abbie Against the Storm**

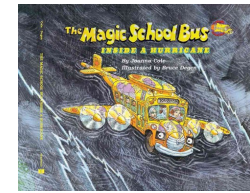
**Bear Feels Scared**

The morning after a hurricane, two brothers find an uprooted tree which becomes a magical place, transporting them on adventures limited only by their imaginations.



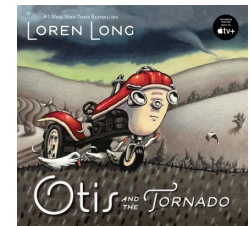
**The Magic School Bus Inside a Hurricane**
